Dear member / parents of Maghaberry HAZAMA Judo School

It is a fact that the activities of this club fall into a category of a 'dangerous sport'. It is also a fact that this club endeavours to ensure the safety of all participants in our activities through a professional approach to the training and facilities provided.

We are required by law to take out a liability insurance policy in the event of accident. This is an expensive but necessary expenditure. A condition imposed by the insurance company is that all participants of this club (and indeed all clubs) are licenced with the Northern Ireland Judo Federation

The onus to register with the Northern Ireland Judo Federation lies with all members (or parents) and not this club. However, in the event of an injury being sustained by a participant who was not currently registered the indemnity provided by the insurance policy would be void. It is for this reason that the club has a duty to ensure full compliance with the requirements of the insurance company and the law, therefore, all members must produce to a committee member their current NIJF licence for inspection

Regrettably no club member can be permitted to avail of the clubs facilities or training until they have registered with the club, paid their annual membership fee and produced their current NIJF licence.
